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Important Conditions

- 1. Both Proposer and Seconder for the Applicant must have been full members for a period of at least 24 months.
- 2. The Proposer and Seconder will be responsible for the behaviour in the Club of the new member for a period of 12 months after joining.
- 3. Fully completed application forms will be placed on the Club notice board for a minimum of 14 days. This allows members the opportunity to make a written objection should they require.
- 4. The application together with any objections would be considered by the management committee at its next monthly meeting.
- 5. The Management Committee's decision will be communicated to you by e-mail or in writing.

Should you not get a reply within 7 weeks of submitting the application you should contact the Membership Secretary (<u>membership@hardwaysailingclub.co.uk</u>)

- 6. You may subsequently be invited to appear in person for an interview, usually held in February or March. The interview will be with two or three committee members, one being an Officer of the Club. The Applicant's Proposer MUST attend this interview along with the Applicant. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to coordinate this joint attendance.
- 7. If accepted for membership the Applicant must attend a 'New Members Meeting' in the Clubhouse, usually in April.
- 8. If you miss the selection for that particular year you will be duly informed.
- 9. It is important to let the Club know or any change of address or if you no longer wish to be considered for membership. If the Club is unable to contact you, it would result in removal from the waiting list.
- 10. Due to current data protection requirements you must sign below to authorise the Club to store your personal information provided on this form. Your information will only be used for the purposes of your application. You acknowledge that part of the application procedure includes the partial display of this completed form internally in the Clubhouse for a limited period of at least 14 days, in case any member wishes to raise a written objection.
