Ballot papers were required for three of the positions as we had more volunteers than required. Darron Moxham retained the position of Rear Commodore, Claire Blades replaces Ed Pascoe as Storage Officer and the Bar Committee stalwart, Tony Batt, has been joined by Dave Deane and Donna Strong who replace Darron Moxham and Howard Ballard. Welcome to those serving on the Committee for the first time this year.

The first agenda item which proposed a definitive conduct rule with the inclusion of a successful amendment to the proposal, from the floor, was eventually defeated following great debate. The other agenda item which failed to pass was the proposal to move the AGM from a Friday evening, to a Saturday afternoon/evening.

The remaining agenda items were successful and the proposal to use email as the preferred method of communication was also agreed, but only after a amendment from the floor to send a copy by post as well in certain circumstances.

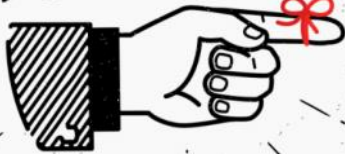

Mooring Vacancies Jan -Feb 2019

DEADLINE Thursday 28th February 2019

To apply you must complete an application form, these are available in mooring folder (above grid diary) and on the HSC website in the members section. This must be posted to or placed in the club post-box.

Please note the club **are only** responsible for allocating the mooring position. The Gear is entirely the responsibility of the member assigned the position. That includes the cost of gear acquisition (either from previous owner or new), the cost of laying and ongoing inspection of the gear.

Once approved by members on the sailing/management committee only applicants who are successful will be informed. Mooring fees will be for 6 months to September 2019 annual renewal date. Fees are currently £5 per foot per year. (½ of this amount will be charged)

RYA – 1st Aid

HSC – Race officer and/or assistant CRO
