Overall winners after 2 races -:



RNLI Race to Yarmouth and Half Wight Race

An early start (9am) of the The RNLI race on Saturday 21st July to Yarmouth. The race was abandoned as no one finished in the time limit of 7 hours despite being very close for the few that chose to persevere right up to the full 7 hours, one boat missing out by only 6 minutes due to light winds and adverse tide.

11 Hardway boats eventually arrived, some earlier than others and had a great evening in Yarmouth, which was very busy. A few gathered at The Wheatsheaf for evening dinner (shown below).

Sunday 22nd July saw all nine boats six Hardway, two Fareham and one from Portchester finish the Half Wight race in light to moderate winds and favourable tide contrary to the forecast of very light winds. Spinnakers hoisted off the Needles and held all the way around the back until Bembridge Ledge buoy which by then winds had picked up to a stiff breeze, although it didn't deter one crew to down tools and abandon their skipper, to go below for a spot of lunch (hot lasagne I believe!) Once approved by members on the sailing/management committee only applicants who are successful will be informed. Mooring fees are currently £5 per foot per year.
